Are you an internationally trained lawyer who would like to practice law in Ontario? If so, you may be qualified for the U of T Faculty of Law's ITL Program.

What is the ITL Program?

The Internationally Trained Lawyers (ITL) Program is a 10-month intensive program commencing in May 2010 that will assist internationally trained lawyers who wish to practice law in Ontario. The program includes: academic courses that will help to prepare you for the NCA Challenge Exams, cultural competency training, career workshops, and short-term work placements.

Who can apply to the ITL Program?

The ITL Program is open to all internationally trained lawyers who have received a law degree in a country other than Canada and are licensed to practice law and a member in good standing in that country. Applicants must also be a Canadian Citizen, a Permanent Resident, or a Convention Refugee.

What is the deadline for applying?

The deadline for submitting your application and all supporting documents to the ITL Program is **February 1, 2010**. All supporting documents must be received before your Application for Admission will be considered
